

***Properly Name the generic World imaged icons on right side of Dock***

1. Open Google.com .When page opens drag Google.com URL title into the right side of Dock. The installed icon will be a generic World icon. The Globe is initially installed on all websites dragged into the right side of Dock

2. Drag the Google.com URL website name onto the Desktop. It will then appear as a Google.webloc

Note: These instructions use Google as an illustrative base as an example

3. Go to Google and search for Google icons. Select one by clicking on View Image and dragging the image onto the Desktop. Next double click the image icon to open it inPreview, Then go to the Preview toolbar: Preview > Edit > Copy

4. Click on the Google .webloc to highlight the title and go to Finder toolbar > File > Get Info. A detailed info page will open on left side of Desktop.

5. Go to the Info page on left of screen and double click on the .webloc image to select it. Image will now be surrounded with a blue frame. Now go to the Finder toolbar > Edit > Paste. You newly selected image will now be inserted in place of the .webloc image on the Get Info page, and on the google.webloc on the Desktop.

6. Drag the Google identified .webloc onto the right side of your Dock.

7. You can now drag the previous generic Google generic World icon URL to the top of Desktop to remove it.
