

Mac OS Sierra

- * Siri- What can I ask you?/ on iOS : "Hey Siri"
- * Drag files between application windows
- * Take control of status menu items (option key)
- * Adjust the date and time

- * Voice dictation and voice control
- * SP > keyboard> dictation then turn on dictation
- * (fn key 2x) see example Historic St Augustine

Can also activate SIRI:

SP > Accessibility > Dictation

 Edit > speech > Start speaking

 Edit > speech> Stop speaking

 trigger phrase, "Computer": Start Siri, close Siri, Search spotlight for..., open mail, scroll up, etc.

 Uses: safari, mail, iBooks.

- * Text to Speech

(opt. + esc)

- * Enlarge part of the screen using zoom control
- * (Opt+ command + 8)
- * Take pictures of the screen (command shift + 3 (command shift + 4)
 quicklook use spacebar

*Print to PDF

- * Customize Finder windows (can't have sidebar if toolbar is disabled)
- * Change icons for files and folders (command + i)
- * Record audio & video in Quiet Time finder > applications
- * Manage available disk space go to: Applications >Utilities > system info > See windows at the top open > Go to storage Management
